# Equivalent Form 5 - Termination

## LEGEND

**Box 1:** Name of the participant.

**Box 2:** Participant Identification Number.

**Box 6:** The time period for doses listed in Boxes 10 through 18.

**Box 9A:** Indicates an exposure was measured or estimated.

**Box 9B:** Indicates if the exposure during the year was “Routine” or “Planned Special Exposure.”

**Box 10:** Includes any information that has been provided to Landauer for internal radiation monitoring.

**Boxes 11-18:** The doses received during the Monitoring Period listed in Box 6.

**Box 19:** The total amount of exposure from Inception Date (found in lower left corner of report) to the date the report was generated (found in Box 21). Also, this box could include the previous history dose obtained from different employers or while being monitored by a different dosimeter provider, if the doses have been communicated to Landauer.

**Box 21:** The date this report was generated.

**A:** The date the participant started being monitored by Landauer.

## GENERAL FACTS

- **Purpose:** The Equivalent Form 5 - Termination details dose history for a participant for the last year the participant was at a given location. The report also displays the lifetime dose for the participant.
- If the account is set up to receive this report, it is generated automatically, 45 days after the employee terminates its activity at the Licensee. At the request of the customer, the report can be generated on demand.
- The report is generated and mailed to the primary reporting address listed at the subaccount level.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### What do I do with this report?

Please consult your State Regulations for specific requirements as each state has its own requirements.

### What do I do with this report if the participant has left my facility?

This report can be sent to the participant's new facility, in order to account for the dose received while the participant was employed at your facility.

### If I switch companies, and both my old company and new company use Landauer dosimeters, can my dose be transferred?

The employer can request, in writing, to have the dose records transferred from a previous employer to a new employer. Once the request is made and the dose data is provided, Landauer can transfer the participant's dose history.

### For some of my doses, I only see “ND.” What does “ND” mean?

“ND” stands for non-detectable. Non-detectable exposures are below the reporting capabilities. If you see an “ND” in any box, it is likely the participant had minimal exposure (designated by an “M” on other Landauer reports) throughout the year.

### If a participant is active in two subaccounts and is terminated from both subaccounts at the same time, will he or she get two reports?

No, he or she will only receive one report with the doses summed across both subaccounts.
